

Parlamento 2030 is an innovative platform created to track, gather and offer the information of national Parliaments' activity related to the Agenda 2030.

Designed to overcome the challenges of the cross-cutting nature of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), Parlamento 2030 classifies the information related to the SDGs through an advanced system of automatic massive tagging. This groundbreaking technology enables users to navigate SDG-related parliamentary activity through a free and open online search browser. The information provided is key for the monitoring and accountability of the implementation of the Agenda 2030 at the national level.

Parlamento 2030 is the most technologically advanced tool designed for the public monitoring of the SDG-related parliamentary activity and it is currently implemented in Spain.

How does it work?

Parlamento 2030 builds a database with all the information published by the Parliament and classifies it, through an automatic process of massive-tagging, according to its linkage to any specific SDG goal and target. It combines advanced computer science - needed to scrap thousand of PDF files where legislation is published and transform them into a structured database with the design of a SDG-thesaurus, that automatically link political initiatives to their related goals and targets. Then, through an intuitive, attractive and accessible interface, all relevant information is provided in a reusable format. Users can select their own search parameters to tailor their inquiries according to their specific needs.

What answers does it provide?

Parlamento 2030 helps to find easy answers to no-so-obvious political analysis questions: Which are the SDGs affected by a certain legislative initiative? Which of the Agenda 2030's goals or targets receive the most attention by MPs, and which are being left behind? Which MPs are most active in the implementation of the 2030 Agenda, and which are neglecting it? It also provides essential inputs to analyze the policy coherence in the implementation of the Agenda 2030 by highlighting, for example, how closely-related political initiatives are being proposed and discussed uncoordinatedly across different parliamentary committees.

Today it is implemented in Spain. But, can it be adapted to other countries?

Yes, it can. The technology used for **Parlamento 2030** is currently applied to the Spanish Parliament due to the endeavour of the Spanish Government, who has include it as part of the Spanish National Action Plan for the implementation of the Agenda 2030, presented to United Nations at the Spanish Voluntary National Report during the 2018 HLPF.

Whether it is another country, a region or the EU Parliament who shows interest, its technology can be quickly adapted to another country or another level of government and be implemented in a short period of time, due the open source and code used.
