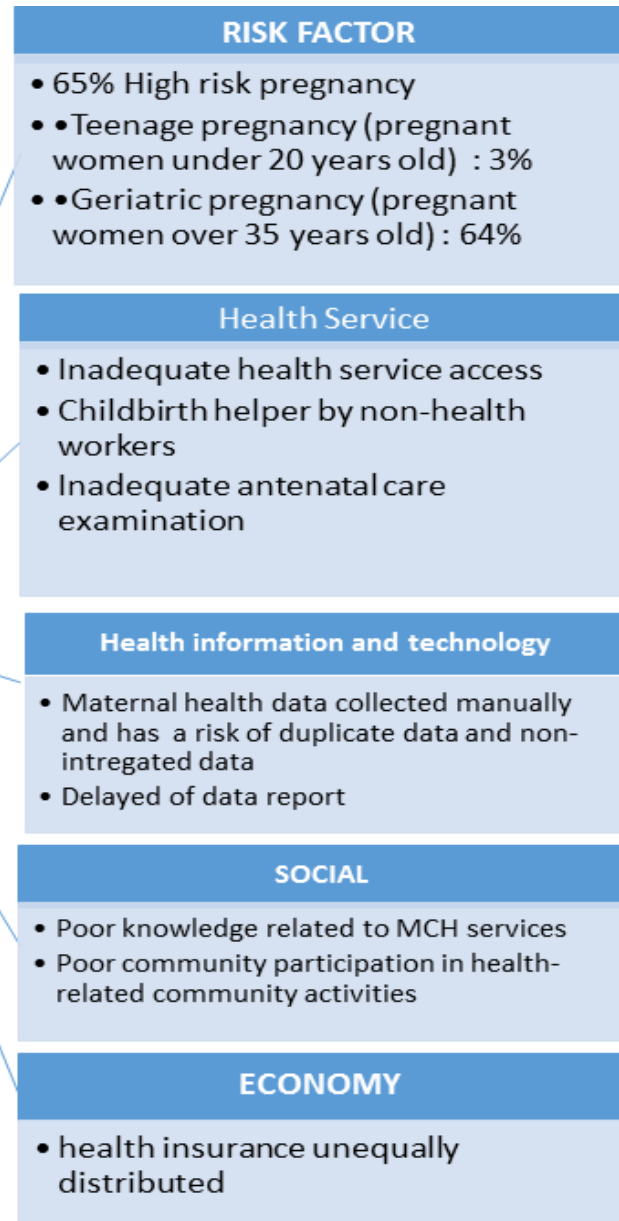
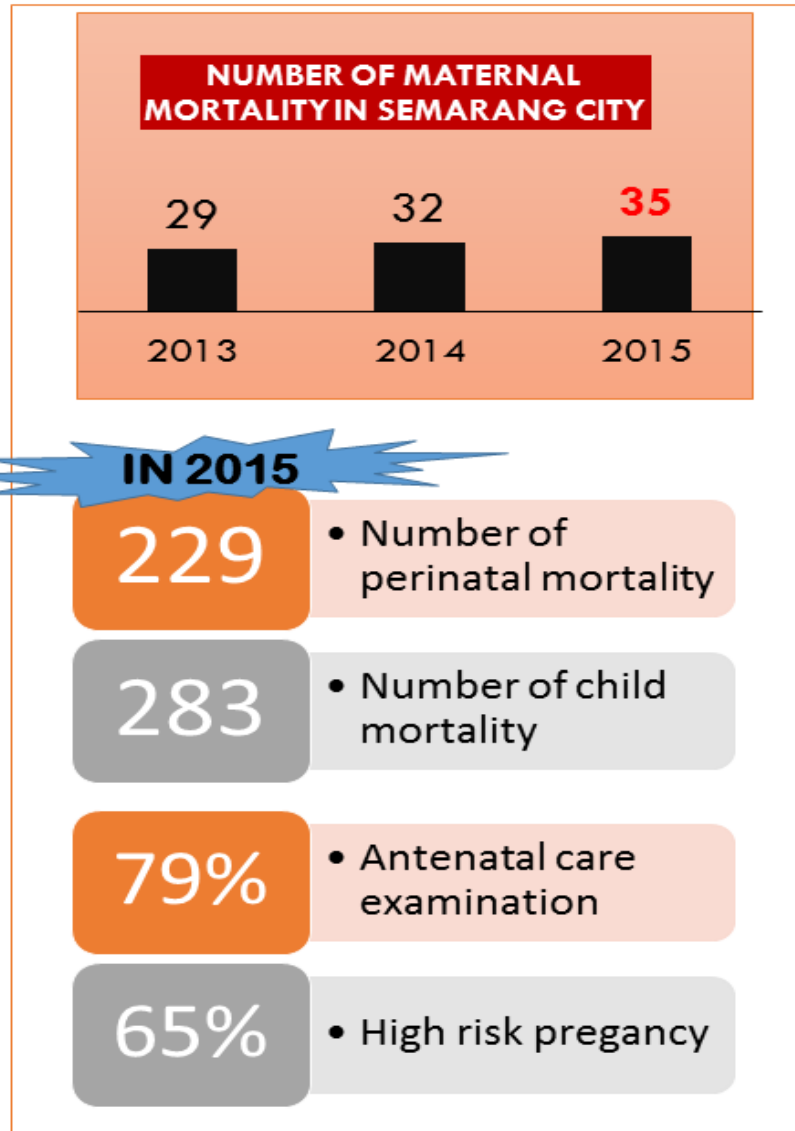

SAN PIISAN

1. Data collection, reporting, and health screening of pregnant women, postpartum women, infants and toddlers by village health volunteers (kader)
2. Assistance for pregnant women, postpartum and toddlers by health workers with the community
3. Health education through counseling, classes for pregnant women, classes for mothers of toddlers
4. Women's health services at workplace
5. Free delivery services and health insurance through the "RAISA" program
6. Provision of additional food for pregnant women, infants and toddlers
7. Referral for mothers with emergency conditions
8. Integrated single data reporting

IMPACT OF CARE SANPIISAN

Mrs CH is high risk with a gynaecological tumour surgery, should not be pregnant because it affects the mother's condition.

However, the cadre found that she was 10 weeks pregnant. During the second monitoring visit by Kader, PKK, BINTARA PEMBINA DESA and Health Worker assitent.

The mother was suddenly in pain and could hardly walk. Because access to the house is through a narrow road, Babinsa carried the mother to be referred using an ambulance.
